SCHOOL BACKGROUND AND MISSION

Westover is an independent college preparatory boarding and day school for young women in grades 9 - 12. Founded in 1909, Westover is located halfway between New York City and Boston. Westover empowers young women to lead lives of consequence.

GRADING

Westover grades on a letter scale with a 4.0 GPA conversion, D- or a 0.7 GPA being passing and B or a 3.0 GPA and above being considered an honors grade. A minimum of 60 (D-) is required to meet graduation requirements. Weighted GPA: AP courses are awarded 8 points, Honors courses are awarded 5 points.

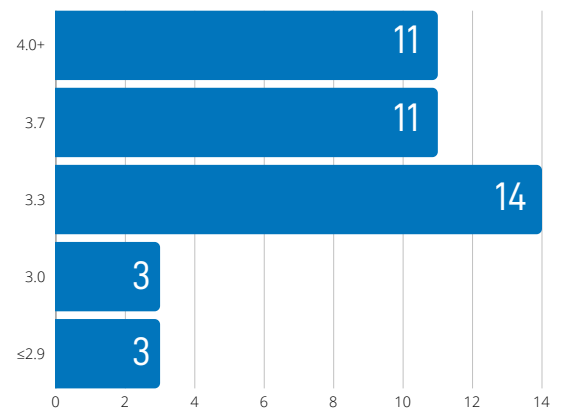
